## CASA Golf Tournament set

All proceeds from the tournament will help CASA of the 31st Judicial District fulfill its mission to provide a voice for children.

# Tourism Board gives nod to two grant applications

## Mexican Fiesta and AirFest to receive financial assistance

On Monday, July 24<sup>th</sup> the Chanute Tourism Board awarded two grant applications to assist in the funding of local tourism events. Each event is expected to attract as many as 2,000 local and area residents, and tourists from across the Midwest.

The board voted to award the 89<sup>th</sup> **Chanute Mexican Fiesta** up to \$900 towards the production cost of brochures for the festival. The annual celebration will be held September 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> at the fiesta grounds in Santa Fe Park. This is the fourth year that the Chamber's tourism program has partnered with the fiesta committee to produce and mail the event brochure to more than 60 communities across the state of Kansas, Oklahoma and Missouri. The fiesta committee has also announced plans to bring the Saturday morning program back to downtown Chanute. According to Chamber Director Jodi Lucke, the program of music and dancing will be held in the Irene Neely Hudson pocket park from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. The Chamber is working with the fiesta committee to coordinate the morning activities.

The tourism board also voted to contribute \$500 to the **2006 Chanute Air-Fest** set for Saturday, August 5<sup>th</sup> at the Martin Johnson Airport. The Air-Fest is sponsored by the Chanute Aviation Association and has been held for more than 10 years. The grant money will be used to assist in the cost of fuel for visiting airplanes and three aerial acrobatic performers.

"The Chamber's grant program is a wonderful vehicle to assist local tourist attractions and special events," Lucke said. "I am very pleased that the board voted to support these very worthwhile activities and give a financial boost to those who work so hard to make these events successful."

Under the direction of the Chanute Area Chamber of Commerce, the Tourism Grant Program was developed to assist local tourism attractions with the expenses associated with their events. The funds come from an excess of transient tax dollars collected above the cost of running the program. Applicants must complete a grant application and meet specific criteria to be considered for the program. Nearly 100% of all grant money issued through the program has been spent locally. Past beneficiaries include the Chanute Art Gallery, Martin and Osa Johnson Safari Museum, and the Chanute American Legion Baseball program.

The tourism board meets at 11:30 a.m. on the fourth Monday of the month at the Safari Grill. All meetings are open to the public and participation from local residents is encouraged.
